JOHN MORRIS TO SPEAK ON LONG BEACH COASTLINE CLEAN-UP

(Long Beach, CA) – At the Westside Project Area Committee's May Meeting, Long Beach business owner John Morris will give a power-point presentation outlining his thoughts on how the Port can take action toward cleaning up the air and water pollution troubling the Long Beach coastline.

Some of the points that will be outlined include a one-time container fee to pay for City infrastructure, expanding the boundaries of the Tidelands, and diverting the Los Angeles River toward the Port instead of the shoreline, which is what happened during the Port expansion of Pier J.

Mr. Morris will make this presentation at the WPAC's next General Meeting scheduled for Wednesday, May 14, beginning at 5 P.M. The WPAC meets at the West Division Sub-station located at 1835 Santa Fe Ave. The public is invited to attend and see this thought-provoking presentation.
